





1. Which UNISON region do you work in?













6. By Monday 15 June, which groups does your school plan to be open to? (Select all that apply)








10. If not, in what way was it different? (Select all that apply)




12. Do you have to take public transport to get to work?

13. Roughly what proportion of eligible children have attended as your school/nursery has opened more widely?









20. Is the limited class size proving an effective way of preventing large groups of children and staff from mixing?




22. What is the maximum agreed number of children in each 'bubble' in your nursery?





27. Was training provided for staff on the health and safety measures in place prior to opening more widely?






29. Do you think your school would be able to cope with more pupils from other year groups attending ahead of the summer break?





30. To what extent has usual learning been taking place?









33. Are any staff other than cleaners being asked to clean classrooms and/or resources?






35. Has your school/nursery provided PPE to staff who need it following a risk assessment?









39. Has your school/nursery given you any detail on how the government test, trace and isolate infrastructure will work locally? - comments




40. Do you normally lead classes to cover teacher PPA time, absences or in an HLTA role?


41. Is your school now expecting you to lead classes to cover for absences and/or teacher PPA time?








43. Has the school's/nursery's cleaning service been increased?


44. Who is undertaking 'deep cleaning' in the event of a Covid case?
