

UNISON Political funds transfer form

Form to transfer contributions between the two sections: the affiliated political fund (UNISON Labour Link) and the general political fund. Members who pay into either of the two sections of the UNISON Political Fund can opt to transfer their payments from one to the other. This involves those who presently contribute to the Affiliated Political Fund (UNISON Labour Link) or the General Political Fund (GPF).

UNISON's Affiliated Political Fund campaigns for members through affiliation to the Labour Party both nationally and locally. Members can take part in Labour Link activities and help make policy in the Labour Party. We work with the UNISON group of Labour MPs and liaise with Labour MEPs in the European Parliament, so members' views are heard where it matters. Regular Labour Link magazines keep members informed.

UNISON's General Political Fund is used to pay for campaigning at branch, regional and national levels of the union as well as for research and lobbying in parliament. It is independent of support for any political party. It liaises with the UNISON groups of MPs and MEPs to pursue members' interests. In the run-up to general or local elections, the fund has been used for effective advertising campaigns to ensure that issues of importance to UNISON are high on the agenda.
