DESCRIPTION

How to apply for members courses

Your Branch will then forward your application to the UNISON Regional Office to book your place on the course. Branches should send application forms to our Regional Education Administrator by email at educationse@unison.co.uk or by post to UNISON, Ranger House, Walnut Tree Close, Guildford GU1 4UL. Scanned applications will be accepted and do not need to be sent by post.

Please note that applications must be signed by a Branch Officer to give approval for the delegate to attend the course. If an application form is not complete then it will be returned to the Branch and a place on the course will not be confirmed until the authorised form is received in the Regional Office.

Can I claim travel expenses to attend a course?

Yes, you can claim any travel expenses you incur by attending a course from your local UNISON Branch by completing an expense claim form. As allowances vary from branch to branch you are advised to check how much you can claim before you apply to attend the course. The Branch Secretary or Branch Education Coordinator will be able to help you.

Do I have to pay to attend this course?

No, this course is free to UNISON members. There is a charge to the Branch of £20 per member.

I have special dietary requirements, will they be catered for?

In most instances special dietary requirements can be met. It is essential that you let us know of these when completing the application form.
