Factsheet 9 Online Anti-Racist Toolkit

Bill Acharjee, SE Regional Black Members Committee member has created a Padlet online toolkit.

Padlets are online noticeboard tools which allow users to share text, images, audio, video and links to documents and web pages. This Padlet has been designed to provide information, news, and resources on anti-racism for the University's minority ethnic community and allies.

Bill Acharjee, Black Members Officer at University of Brighton UNISON branch, SERBMC member said: "Racism is a very complex social construct and often hard to define and to talk about. We also understand that the Brighton community may be at different levels of racial awareness and how it manifests in society and the workplace, or how to deal with it."

With this in mind, the Padlet has been developed to be an A-Z guide, and a starting point, for our stakeholders to use to support their learning in becoming anti-racist and supporting their minority ethnic colleagues and peers.

The Padlet is an attempt to aid the learning process for everyone. The lived experiences of minority ethnic people will be unique and differ from each other, but the University of Brighton Anti-Racist Toolkit is a good starting point! It can also be used by anyone as a reference point and enable them to share information of their own as they engage with its contents.

It will be updated regularly, and colleagues are encouraged to save it in their browser bookmarks for ease of reference.
